

CERAMIC RELIEF TILE TWO DAY WORKSHOP

With **JOEL SMOKER**: Dip Teach, A.A.Dip, BA, B Ed, Cert IV (Photo)

Produce a series of Ceramic Relief Tiles from a plaster mould based on your original ceramic relief tile. This is a project that is suitable for an Upper School Art class.

PROJECT STEPS

DAY 1

- A series of drawings of succulents and cacti.
- A series of drawings of background images
- A series of tile designs (13 cm x 13 cm) based on these drawings.
- Produce a clay relief tile of your chosen design.
- Produce a plaster mould of the tile.
- Make a series of clay glaze sample tiles.

DAY 2

- Remove clay from mould.
- Roll slab of clay and place in mould.
- Add lugs to back of tile.
- Remove tile and repeat the process.
- Apply underglaze and glaze to sample tiles.
